

Computer and Internet Use Policy

The Minneapolis Community & Technical College Library's primary mission is to serve the research and information needs of the students, faculty and staff of the college. In addition to serving the Library's primary clientele, the Library also provides limited services to members of the MnSCU system and residents of the city of Minneapolis.

1. The Library's public computer workstations exist to support the research needs of MCTC students, faculty and staff. The public workstations provide access to online databases, the Internet, and campus resources. A student, faculty or staff person using a library computer for other than research purposes may be asked to surrender use of the computer workstation. Residents of the broader community may use the Library's public computer workstations if such use does not interfere with the research needs of the campus community.

3. The Library's public computer workstations do not support word processing, email, WebCT, chat rooms, or instant messaging.
