

There are 68 TRiO programs in Minnesota's public and private institutions, 48 of which are in 22 of the Minnesota State College and Universities (MnSCU) institutions. MCTC has six TRiO programs, more than any other higher education institution in Minnesota.

TRiO programs serve over 16,000 low-income, first-generation youth and adults in Minnesota each year. At least two-thirds of the students served must come from families with incomes under \$28,000, where neither parent graduated from college.
