

Enhancing Your Online Learning Through Video

An excellent way to offer your students timely, interactive education is through video.

Even if working off campus, you still have access to the great tools available in [Zoom](#), [D2L](#), and [Kaltura MediaSpace](#).

Here are three steps for creating a video:

- Record the video in Zoom
- Host the video in MediaSpace
- Share the video in D2L

Recording Zoom Meetings

Access the completed .mp4 video file in your computer's Documents folder.

Tip: Create a short test video to ensure your microphone and screen-sharing functions work as desired.

Hosting a Video in Kaltura MediaSpace

Log in to your [Kaltura MediaSpace](#) account using your StarID and password.

Upload the video to your account:

- Click the Add New button
- Click Media Upload
- Drag the .mp4 into the upload field

The video will begin processing and be available for use shortly.

Ensuring Video Accessibility

Once your video has finished processing, complete the following steps to ensure accessibility through closed captioning:

- [Order machine captioning in MediaSpace](#)
- [Edit the resulting captioning yourself](#)
 - o Or, add the Captioning Coordinator Britt Mammenga as a [Co-Editor Collaborator](#), and she will finalize the captioning for you. Her StarID is: hh7436xa

Sharing the Video with your Class

Now that the video lives in Kaltura MediaSpace, you can share the video's link with your students. You can simply copy and paste the video's link into D2L, or even in an email.
