

Excluded PSEO Programs/Classes

The following courses are not covered by PSEO funding and ineligible for PSEO enrollment at MCTC:

- All courses numbered under 1000 (Example: Read 0200, Eng 0900, Math 0070, etc.)
- All overseas courses
- All non-credit courses offered through our Continuing Education and Training Department

For academic, financial and logistical reasons, not all MCTC courses are eligible to PSEO students. In many situations, the Online registration system prevents PSEO students from enrolling in ineligible courses (e.g., pre-requisite coursework needed, program admission required, etc.) PSEO students who intentionally register for PSEO ineligible courses will be dropped unless prior arrangements have been made with the PSEO coordinator. In those cases, the student will be responsible for the payment of all costs associated with their enrollment including tuition, student fees, books and supplies.
